Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord,  
*Welcome!*

It is good to have you join the Sacred Heart worshiping community as we celebrate our Eucharistic Liturgy for the 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. Your presence and prayerful participation enrich our Liturgy. May the Risen Lord nurture our spirit and strengthen our faith through this prayerful gathering. Thanks for joining us!

In today's Second Reading, St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians, Paul encourages us to "seek what is above." Paul wants us to "put to death" those aspects of us that are "earthly." In his list of things we are to "put to death" he includes "greed that is idolatry." We are not to make the things of earth our "gods." We are not to worship the accumulation of money and possessions. In the Book of Ecclesiastes the author sees "property" as "vanity." "Vanity" denotes emptiness or illusion. Being obsessed with the things of this world is "vanity." Jesus, in today's Gospel, addresses the "greed" theme in warning the crowd, "take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." In his parable Jesus speaks of the "rich man" who stores his "bountiful harvest" in his newly built barns. God calls the "rich man" a fool. He stored up treasure for himself rather than becoming "rich in what matters to God." What does it mean for us to be "rich in what matters to God." It is a question for us to ponder!

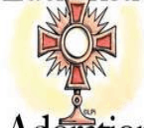
