Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,
Welcome to Sacred Heart Church!

I rejoice in your presence with our worshipping community as we celebrate our Eucharistic Liturgy for the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Your prayerful participation enriches all who gather to receive God's blessings in the Word proclaimed and the Eucharist we share. Thanks for joining us!

In today's Gospel, Jesus says to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." The synagogue official, Jairus, had pleaded with Jesus to come and "lay your hands on" his daughter for she "is at the point of death." Have you ever pleaded with God? Have you ever sought healing for yourself or another in prayer? I think most of us have carried the sick to the Lord in prayer. We, like Jairus, have pleaded for healing, for wellness, of a loved one. Often we may feel our prayers were unsuccessful, that God failed to answer our request. THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Understood in the light of the Scriptures, the term "Sacred Heart of Jesus" denotes the entire mystery of Christ, the totality of His being. For those unfamiliar with the tradition of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, this devotion was spread by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun, during the late 1600's. St Margaret Mary received revelations from our Lord asking her to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart as a symbol of His love. The revelations culminated in a vision experienced by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque on the Feast of Corpus Christi in 1675, when our Lord appeared to her, and said, "Behold the heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing, even exhausting and consuming itself in testimony of its love."

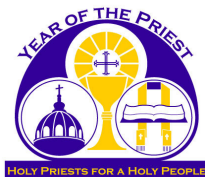
