### **RCIA**

**The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** the process by which people become members of the Roman Catholic Church. This process is concerned with the total formation of the person into believing, living with, praying with, and serving with the Church community. This gradual development culminates in the celebration of the Initiation Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist at Easter time.
